Part 4 Voice : working with others

Case study examples of 'voice' in practice. These are most useful to individuals and groups who are already familiar with 'voice'.

Working with voice slides : - this is the second set of powerpoint presentation slides. This set is intended to help people to take groups through the different aspects of

'voice', facilitating discussion, explaining what 'voice' can offer and helping groups to assess, plot and plan to increase their influence.

Toolkit to encourage facilitation - provides ideas on methods which may help groups to work in participatory and inclusive ways, support facilitators to recognise and challenge discrimination, and outline different ways of learning.
